

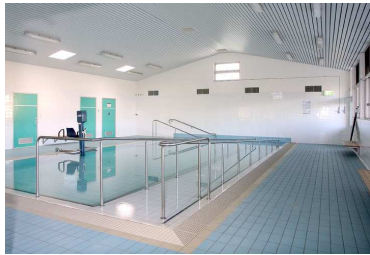
**AXIOM 2 SCHOOLS PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS (PPP) II, NSW**

The current PPP project includes three high schools and one special school. All four facilities are greenfield projects.

Civil works on all the projects in design were carried out in 3D, to ensure balanced earthworks and co-ordination with other services.

**Halinda School, Whalan, NSW, Special Needs School**



The Government grant provided for a replacement school for specific purposes program.

At a cost of \$4.3 million, the special school consists of five buildings, including a hydrotherapy pool facility.

Total construction cost of around \$8.0 million.

The following high schools consist of approximately ten individual buildings, including gymnasium, canteen, workshops, science labs, administration and general learning areas:

**Rouse Hill High School, Kellyville, NSW**

The Government programme allowed for acquisition of a new school site, at a cost of \$8.82 million.

The final school consists of ten buildings, at a construction cost of around \$18 million.

The school opened for public use in January 2009.



**Kelso High School, Bathurst, NSW**



The high school consists of thirteen individual buildings, including gymnasium, canteen, workshops, science labs, administration and general learning areas. The school was added to the PP delivery list as a result of a major fire, which completely destroyed the original school. The school opened for public use in January 2008.

**Kariong High School, Gosford, NSW**

Currently under construction, this high school consists of six buildings, including general learning, visual arts, movement complex and science buildings. The school construction cost is around \$15 million and is due to be opened to the public in January 2010.
