

WATERGATE APARTMENTS, DOCKLANDS

Watergate apartments is built on a triangular shaped site, in Melbourne's Docklands precinct.

The structure consists of identical twin towers rising from a five storey podium.

The development is a mixed-use commercial, retail and apartment complex, and also includes four-levels of carparking above ground level.

Apartments are designed to function as home/offices and, internally, the apartments have separate arrangements for 'work' and 'home', allowing flexibility in both environments.

The striking feature of this development is the diamond form of the chiselled towers. The perforated steel mesh panels provide a translucent but protective skin, which reflect the harsh sun and reduce solar heat loads, while the coloured glass ends provide further visual effect.
